History

Masia Bach was founded in the early 20th century by two brothers, Pere and Ramón Bach, textile manufacturers. They wanted to bring together the best cotton weaving tradition and winemaking and named their top Masia Bach vineyards after their highest-quality cotton, "Extrísimo".

Tasting notes

Appearance: Intense bright red with a blue rim.

Nose: Intense, with notes of red berries (raspberries and strawberries) and abundant stone fruit (ripe peaches and nectarines). Background of floral notes and grapefruit zest.

Mouth: Elegant, flavoursome entry; very juicy mouthfeel. The sweetness brings forth the fruit notes found in the nose, even adding tropical sensations, like mango. A dab of tartness gives it a long mouthfeel.

The winemaker's recommendations

The wine is expected to reach its full potential during the first year and remain in good condition for a further year. Store in a dry place in the absence of direct sunlight.

Matching

Ideal with many dishes; from starters, rice dishes and pasta, to chocolate desserts and nuts.
